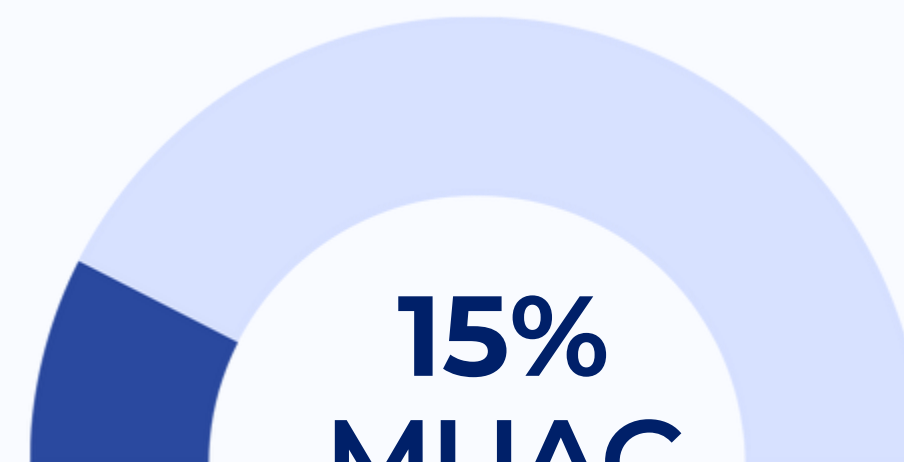

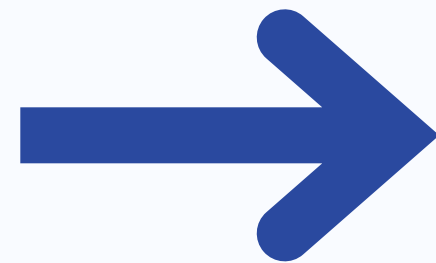

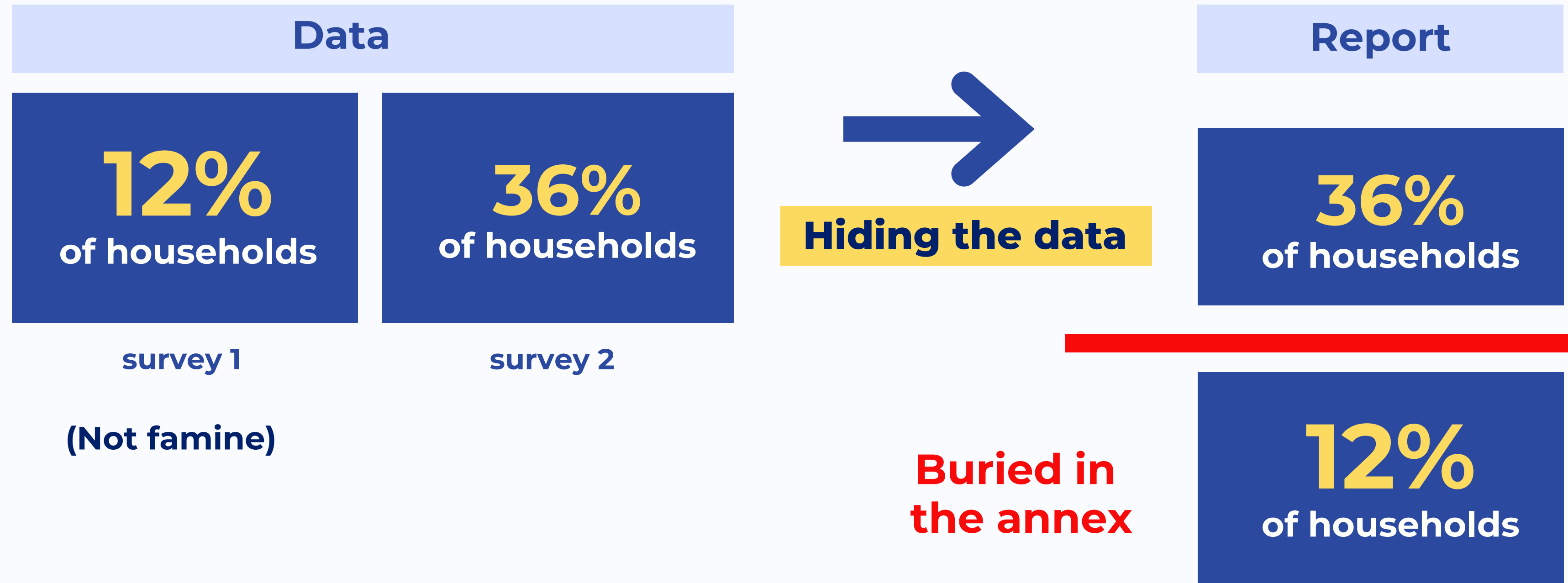

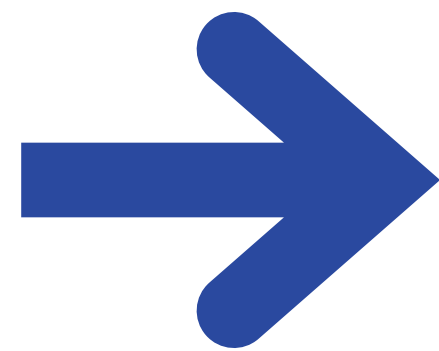

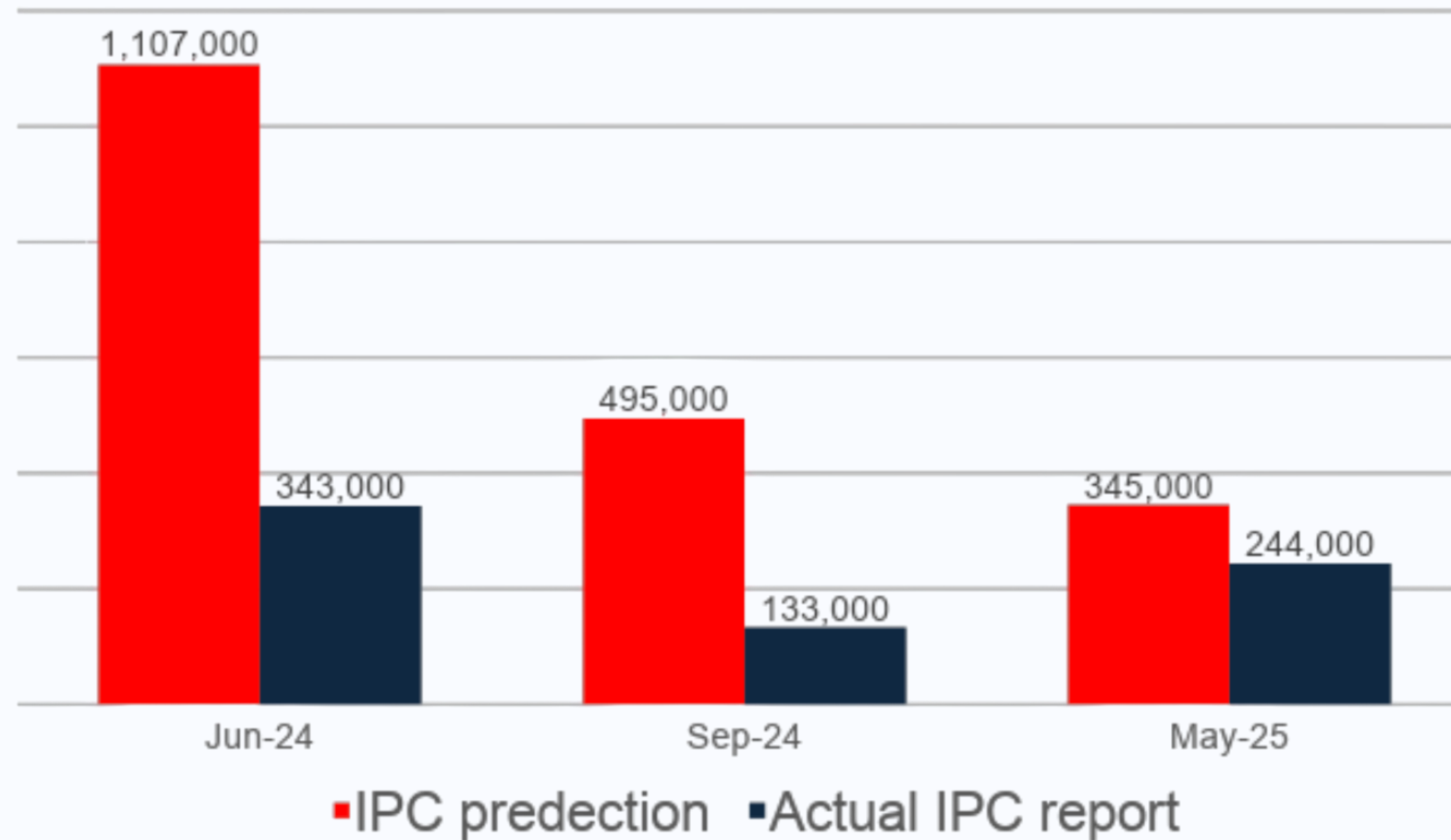

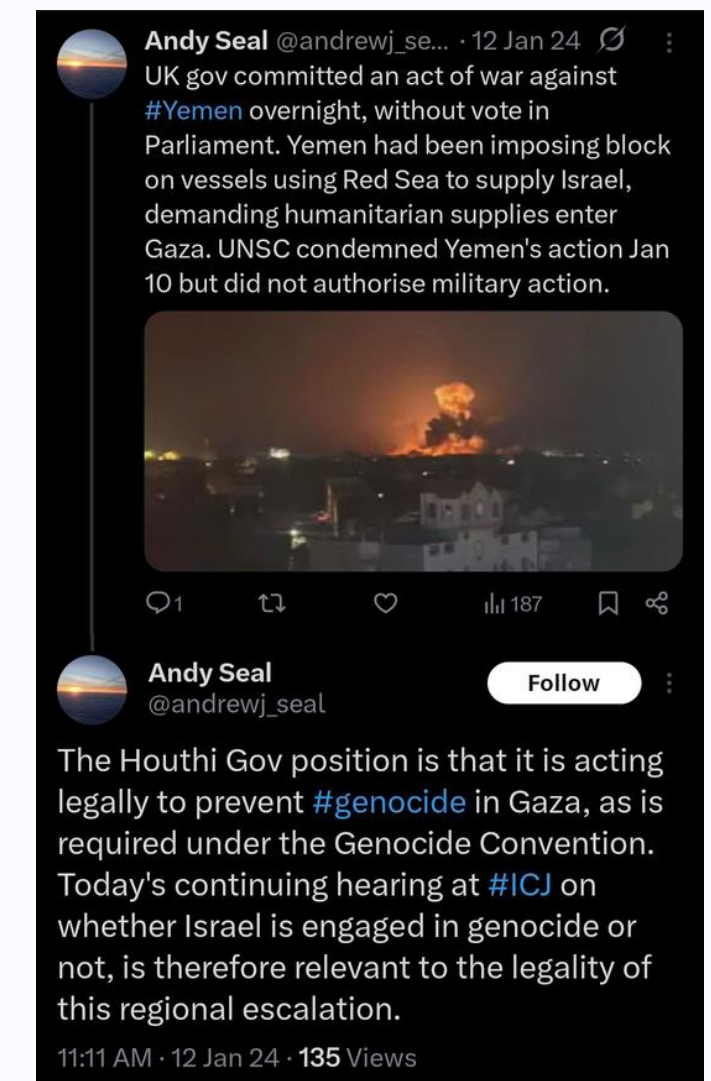

Re: Retraction of the Latest IPC Report on Gaza

I am writing to express Israel's utter denunciation of the latest IPC report on Gaza, issued on 22 August 2025. Israel categorically rejects the report's methodology and conclusion, that famine thresholds have been crossed in Gaza City. The report is deeply flawed, unprofessional, and gravely missing the standards expected from an international body entrusted with such a serious responsibility. What emerges is not a scientific analysis but the selective use and manipulation of data, to reach a predetermined conclusion in order to support Hamas propaganda and the fake 'starvation' campaign.

Preliminary analyses by both official Israeli bodies and independent experts indicate that the report includes:

- Made-up data that doesn't exist;
- breaking the IPC own standards and rules;
- Cherry-picking of data;
- hiding data which contradicts the predetermined conclusion;
- ignoring data;

Methodological faults

The methodological faults in the latest report, as identified in our preliminary analysis, are detailed here for public review: <https://govextra.gov.il/mda/ipc/gaza/>.

This evidence demonstrates how the classification of famine in Gaza City rests on a two-step **distortion of existing data**:

1. **Misrepresenting partial July data** as evidence of both a breach in the GAM threshold and a sharp upward trend.
2. **Carrying this manufactured "exponential rise" into the mortality analysis**, inflating figures by inferring deaths more than thirty times higher than reported, despite all credible evidence showing mortality well below famine levels and most likely declining.

In addition,

3. The IPC **manipulated data** – the IPC took a highly controversial decision to use the 15% GAM according to MUAC as the famine (phase 5) threshold based on a highly dubious analysis which has already drawn significant criticism from the scientific community.
4. **Omitting information** - The IPC's decision to report on Gaza without transparent consultation with and feedback from Israel during the analysis process, as it works with local governments in nearly all other settings.

This is not error. It is methodologically indefensible and substantively misleading **designed to fit a conclusion**. It discredits the IPC process and risks undermining confidence in all future assessments.

These problems compound concerns that Israel has raised with you directly in the past: lack of transparency in sources and methods, failure to demonstrate neutrality, systematic disregard of Israeli humanitarian efforts, and a consistent blindness to Hamas' deliberate exploitation of aid. The latest report, however, goes further. It crosses a line, leaving the impression that the IPC chose to forgo its principles and follow politically-motivated calls on it to declare famine even if the official criteria have not been met. This approach is a stark departure from the IPC's own principles and raises concerns that the accuracy and objectivity of its reports is not its top priority.

Past publications

This is not the first instance in which IPC outputs have been found deficient. Past forecasts regarding Gaza (see under Annex I: Past IPC Forecasts Disproven by Reality) have consistently predicted outcomes far more severe than reality, only to be disproven when facts emerged and even by the IPC's own subsequent reports.

Conclusion

Accordingly, we expect the IPC to conduct an urgent and transparent review of this report that will address methodological breaches and avoid misleading the international community, the public and policymakers. The new report should be made without breaching the rules, and based only on factual data, including the available information, without hiding and without distorting data. We ask that the **IPC formally retract the report and its conclusions until that review is completed**.

As Israel possesses a large database which contradicts the conclusion of the current report, shall the IPC choose to work on a real report, we would be pleased to cooperate and share information. If a new report will not be presented within two weeks, Israel will continue to publicly challenge the validity of IPC findings. Israel will share the hard evidence with the donors of IPC, demanding the halt of the financial support to IPC, in light of its political standing and its reports which conform Hamas terror organization propaganda.
